

One Planet Cardiff Festival / Schools

Friday 14th June 2013 Wales Millennium Centre, Cardiff Bay

Cardiff schools are invited to celebrate what they have achieved, and to find out what else they could do to live a more 'One Planet' lifestyle.

Join with other schools for a half day of workshops on sustainable travel, smarter energy use and waste reduction, with optional visit to Cardiff Bay Wetlands for activities.

- There will be a small exhibition from organisations involved in all aspects of One Planet Living and Sustainability, which pupils and teachers will be able to look around at lunchtime.
- There will be an opportunity for a few schools to visit the Cardiff Bay Wetlands Reserve for activities.
- All workshops will be in English though some of the facilitators are Welsh speaking.

Primary Schools: morning workshops. Up to 6 children in years 4 or 5, who would be able to pass on what they have learned to others when they return to school. The children will take part in series of short workshop sessions, and a final session which will include an awards ceremony as appropriate.

Secondary Schools: afternoon workshops. Up to 6 – 10 students in Years 9 – 10 who can pass on what they have learnt to others at school. The afternoon session will include workshops on issues related to One Planet Living.

Schools taking part will be invited to bring some artwork.
